| 7.15pm | Cooking experience to showcase a traditional Jordanian dish, 'Maqluba' and dinner in the Al Baraqa Tea Room on the fourth floor. |
| 8.30pm | Experience 'Petra by night', a short walk from the hotel - a magical way to see part of the ancient rose rock city, a UNESCO World Heritage site by candlelight. More info on Petra below. |

| 8.45am | Meet in the lobby for a tour of the Petra site by day. Petra is a famous archaeological site in Jordan's southwestern desert. Dating to around 300 BC, it was the capital of the Nabatean Kingdom. Accessed via a narrow canyon called Al Siq, it contains tombs and temples carved into pink sandstone cliffs, earning its nickname, the 'Rose City.' Its most famous structure is Al Khazneh, a temple with an ornate, Greek-style facade. |
| 1pm | Return to the hotel for lunch at, weather-permitting, Al Ghadeer Roof Garden, or if not, Al Iwan restaurant that marries a Middle Eastern setting with a Mediterranean menu. |
| 3.30pm | Departure for Wadi Rum for a jeep ride tour and sunset experience. Wadi Rum also known as The Valley of the Moon is Jordan's largest valley cut into the sandstone and granite rock in the south, 60 km to the east of Aqaba. Sundowners followed by a traditional Bedouin barbeque of 'zarb', roasted lamb and vegetables cooked in a large underground colliery. |
